Gritstone Edges of the Peak District One Day Workshop

This will be my 5th workshop in this stunning region following an article I was commissioned to write for Outdoor Photography in 2010.

The day will be split between 3 Edges; Stanage, Curbar and Baslow and includes a pub lunch. I will begin by demonstrating on a scene, and discuss such things as composition, filtration, reading a histogram, iso settings and the thought process behind the image.

These three edges lie in the east of the Peak District National Park and form an almost continual line of cliffs. Stunning views can be had in all directions with huge boulders, massive gritstone edges and stone walls forming dramatic compositions.

There will be a maximum of 6 participants on a first come first served basis and is suitable for those of all levels and whether you have only recently picked up a camera or have been shooting for years, you are sure to find this an enjoyable and beneficial day. Emphasis will be on creating images with strong visual impact.

I first photographed wild Bison in Bialowieza 9 years ago and now, in conjunction with acclaimed Polish nature photographer, Marek Kosinski, I shall be leading a 6 day photography tour to this amazing place.

Aside from photographing Europe's largest mammal, we will spend time in Marek's hide photographing birds such as nutcracker, hawfinch and grey-headed woodpecker. We will also be photographing within the Specially Protected Area, the finest example of primeval forest in lowland Europe. Let me tell you, stepping into this forest is like going back in time and worth the trip alone. No management has been carried out for over 100 years. Enormous 50 metre high oaks tower above you and within this stunningly eerie forest, bison, wolves, boar and lynx exist. **Please visit my blog through my website for more information.**
