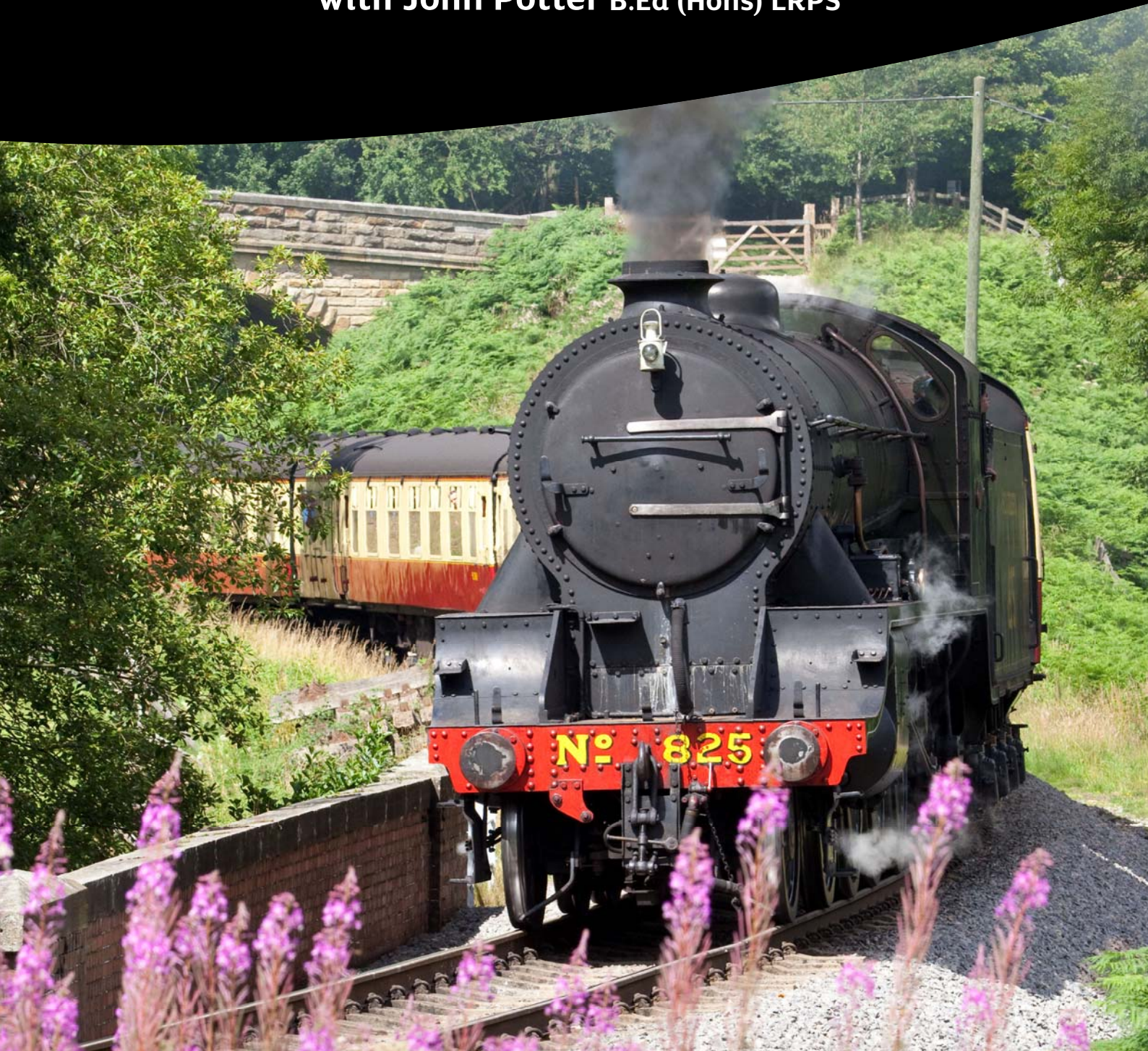


One Day Digital Photography Workshops on the North Yorkshire Moors Railway

North Yorkshire Moors Railway One Day Digital Photography Courses

Friday 30 September (Autumn Steam Gala) & Friday 7 October

These one day workshops are ideal for those wishing to learn to use their digital cameras more creatively, whilst photographing trains, stations, villages and landscapes along the North Yorkshire Moors Railway. Led by professional landscape photographer, author and teacher John Potter, you will learn how to take good quality location and landscape images, and characterful portraits. You will be shown how to use the more creative modes of your camera, so that you can control exposure, depth of field and white balance, and you will be given expert guidance on composition. In the morning session at Pickering you will learn how to use Photoshop Elements to organise, edit and enhance your photos. After lunch you will travel to Goathland on our steam railway for landscape and location photography.

Itinerary

09:45-10:15: Coffee/tea/introductions at the Learning Centre, Pickering Station

10:15-12:00: Morning session learning the basics. Start photographing around Pickering Station. Learn about how Photoshop Elements can be used to modify your photographs.

12:00: Light lunch in Learning Centre, Pickering Station

13:00: Train to Goathland to practice outside and landscape photography

17:00: Finish and return by train to Pickering
